RE: Sanctioning Request: CALGARY SPRING CLASSIC

This is to advise that the sanctioning request for the **CALGARY SPRING CLASSIC (May 19-21, 2017)** has been approved with the following conditions:

1. The tournament will abide by ASA Governance Documents, including the By-laws, Governance Policies and Rules & Regulations (any variation must be approved by ASA);
2. District ID cards (or appropriate photo identification) must be checked for all Senior players/team staff prior to every game;
3. The tournament will use only registered players (1 of 3 methods);
 - a. Registered through 1 of 23 ASA Regular Members
 - b. Approved by a registered Provincial, State or Country Association to travel to Alberta.
 - c. Have paid the temporary Registration fee via the ASA or through the Tournament Organizers.
 - i. Temporary registration list of non-registered players must be provided to the ASA office two days in advance of the tournament start date.
4. ASA per ASA Rules and Regulations only ASA registered referees may be used:
 - a. Tournament Referee in Chief **must** contact Carmen Charron at programs@albertasoccer.com no later than five weeks prior to the tournament to discuss referee requirements
 - b. A list of all referees used must be submitted no later than seven days after the tournament's end. Your event will not be sanctioned in future years if this information is not submitted.
